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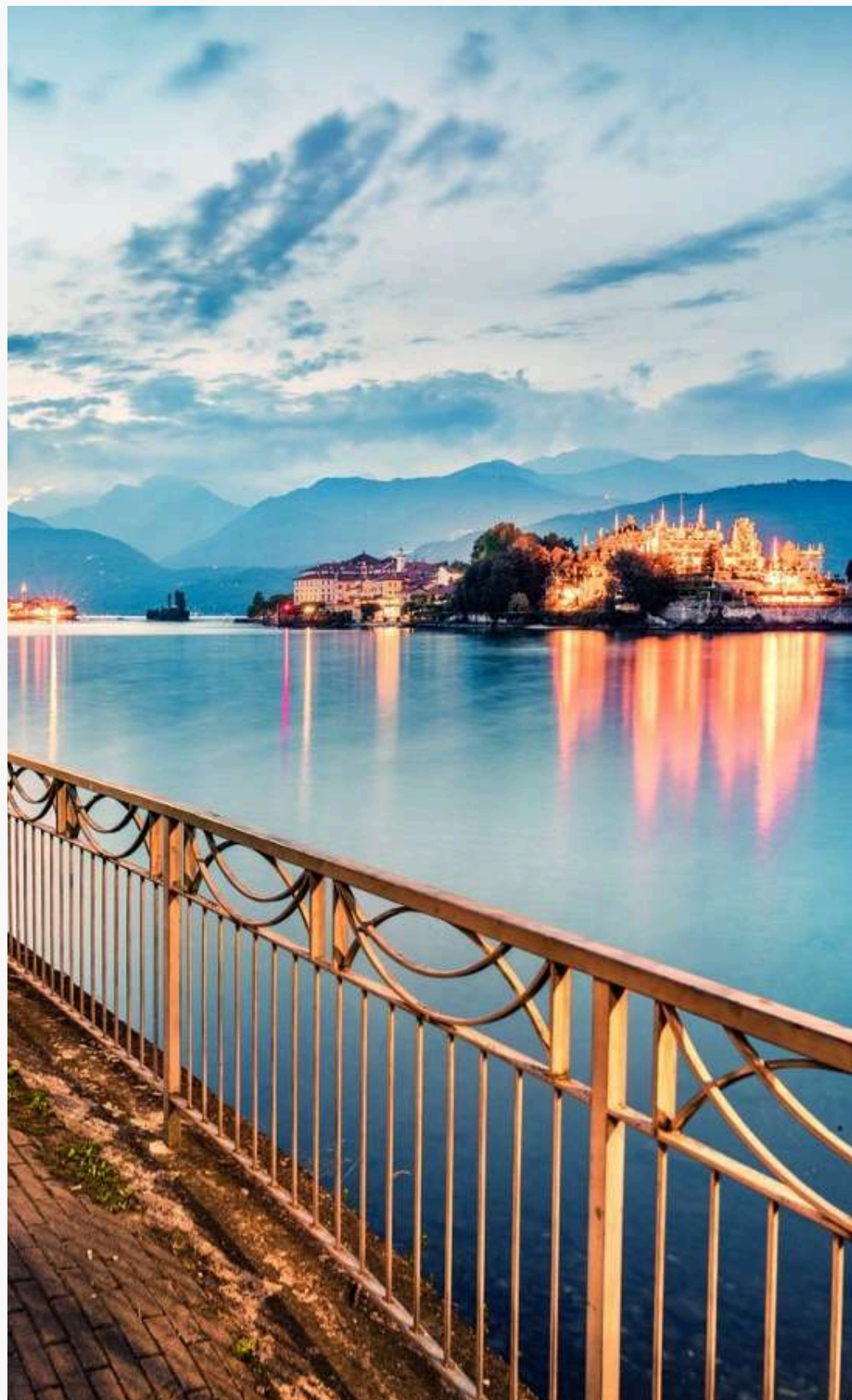

PALLAVICINO PARK

STRESA



Villa Pallavicino became a private residence in 1855, when the area was purchased by Ruggero Bonghi, statesman and man of letters.

There followed the transfer of ownership to the Duke of Vallombrosa and in 1862 the purchase by the noble Genoese Pallavicino family, who enlarged the estate, built roads for vehicles, decorated the park with statues, transforming it from a simple dwelling into the splendid nineteenth-century neoclassical-style villa that still stands on the hill today. But it was Marquise Luisa who completed the work, in 1952, welcoming animals here from every corner of the world to build an exceptional zoo.

In 1956 the Pallavicinos decided to transform their marvellous garden into a wildlife museum that was open to the public.

Since 2017 the Parco Pallavicino has been part of the circuit of the Terre Borromeo.

CANNERO CASTLES

In 1519 Ludovico Borromeo settled on the islets opposite Cannero and Cannobio. Exactly five centuries later the works for the restoration of the Cannero Castles start again. Three years is the time required to transform them into a museum that will tell the story of the castle through the centuries, thanks to the finds discovered during the archaeological excavation campaigns and with the help of appropriate information technology. **No possibility to visit the castles ruins, you can see them only from the coast or if you rent a private boat but no dock is allowed.**

SAN CARLO BORROMEO STATUE

ARONA

The statue of Saint Charles, or “Sancarlone” as the locals call it, stands on the top of a hill (about 310 m./ 900 ft above sea level) just above Arona. Almost 35 m. / 90 ft tall it can even be seen from the lake, half-hidden by the ancient trees which surround it.

The statue is hollow and has an internal structure of stones, bricks and iron. The exterior is finished with sheets of hammered copper. The saint’s blessing arm is a complex metal structure, specially constructed to resist the strong winds in this area.

MOTTARONE

A MOUNTAIN BY THE LAKE



With an altitude of 1.492 Mt. Mottarone is a granite mountain that rises between lakes Maggiore and Orta, between the provinces of Novara and Verbania. From here the gaze is lost in infinity: with the clear sky, the view extends from the Maritime Alps to Monviso, from the nearest Monte Rosa massif to the Swiss Alps, up to the Po Valley. A unique scenario just an hour from Milan.

The Mottarone Park

Bike, trekking, paragliding, climbing in summer and skiing or snowshoeing in winter are some of the activities present within the Mottarone Park. Woods and paths present themselves as the perfect natural gym for experiencing sport in contact with the greenery of the mountain. On two wheels, hanging from the carabiner or on skis, with a breathtaking view far from the frenzy of the city. For those who want, there is also space for a tasty break. At the top, the Rifugio Genziana restaurant is the ideal place to taste the authentic flavors of the Lombardy-Piedmontese mountains. Next to the Mottarone Adventure Park, in summer, the Bar Stazione is the meeting point for gourmet lunch breaks, snacks and aperitifs with 0 kilometer products.

Mottarone Adventure Park and Bar Stazione

Bar Stazione and Mottarone Adventure Park are part of a broader project which concerns the recovery plan supported by Prince Vitaliano Borromeo to safeguard and enhance an ancient widespread heritage of traditional mountain architecture, located on the eastern side of Mottarone.

The interventions paid great attention to the ecological and faunal peculiarities of the area, in order to encourage the settlement and maintenance of local animal species, as well as improving, redeveloping and preserving the woodland surface.

A viewpoint over Lake Maggiore immersed in a unique and evocative natural environment is the scenery surrounding the Bar Stazione and the adjacent Mottarone Adventure Park.

ALPYLAND PARK

Alpyland is the amusement park at the top of Mottarone, a place with a wonderful view!

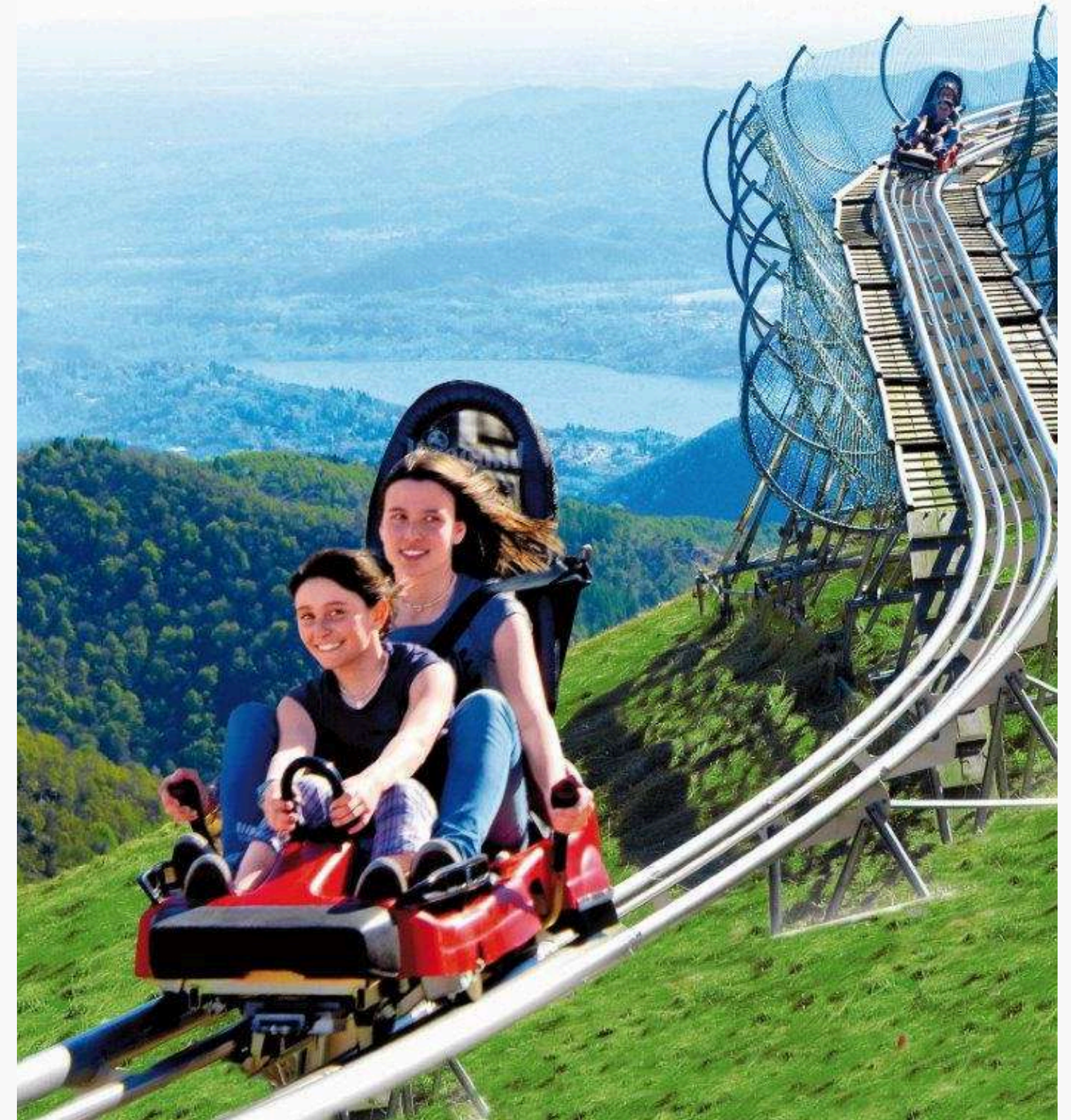
The Alpine Coaster is an attraction similar to a roller coaster, all downhill, with the particularity that each user can decide the speed at which to tackle the track. The two-seater bobsleds are in fact equipped with a braking system that the passenger on the back seat can operate to accelerate or decelerate. The track is 1,200 m long and has a difference in altitude of 100m.

It is open all year round. Monday to Friday from 10am to 5pm. Saturday and Sunday, from 10am to 6pm.

In the winter period (from November to March) the slope is only open on weekends and during the Christmas holidays. In the summer period (April to October) the track is open every day.

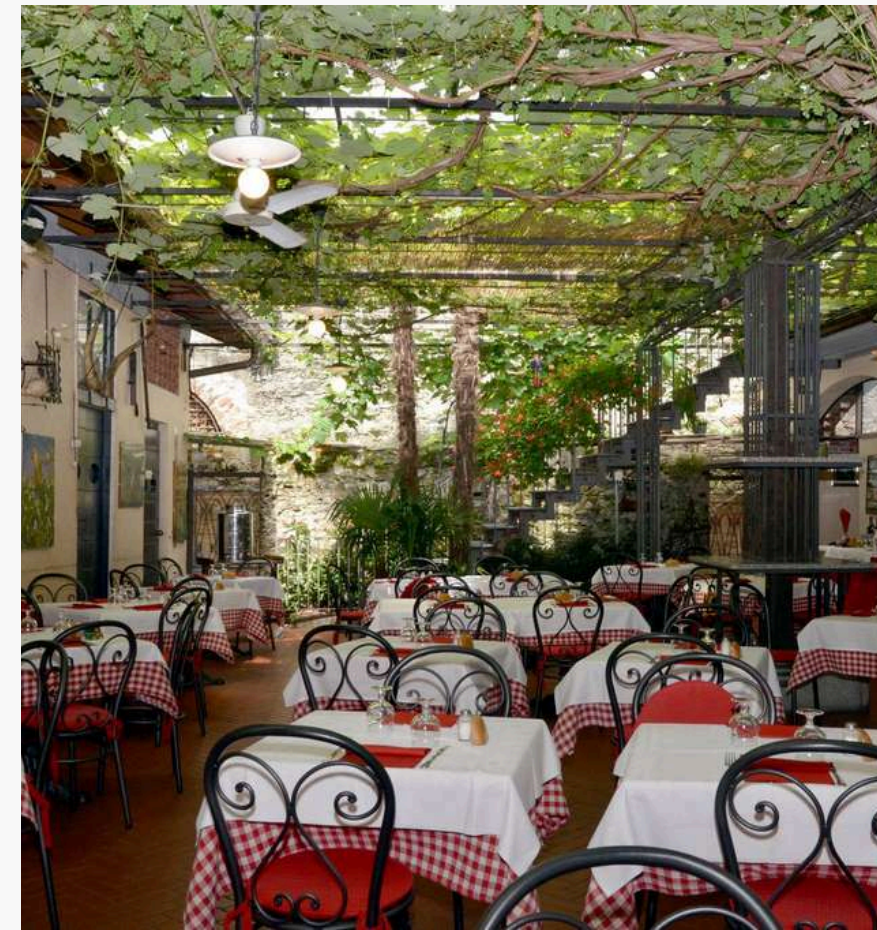

ROCCA D'ANGERA

The spectacular Rocca di Angera is the perfectly harmonious accumulation of five different constructions, built starting from the 11th century and until the 17th: the Torre Castellana, the Ala Scaligera, the Ala Viscontea, the Torre di Giovanni Visconti and the Ala dei Borromeo.

It is impossible not to be astounded by the dimensions and grandeur of this building and by the solemnity of the Sala del Buon Romano, the Sala delle Mitologia, the Sala delle Ceremonie, the Sala di San Carlo and the Sala dei Fasti Borromeo, where large canvases, portraits and furnishings take you back to ancient times.

SANTA CATERINA DEL SASSO

HERMITAGE

Clinging to a rock face directly overhanging the lake, the Hermitage of Santa Caterina del Sasso is certainly one of the most charming sights of Lago Maggiore.

The entrance to the church is through a portico consisting of four round, renaissance-style arches. The structure of the current building is truly unique, the fusion of three chapels, originally built separately in three different eras. There are numerous pictorial cycles both inside and outside the Church, mainly covering the period running between the 14th and the 19th century. Art and history merge wonderfully in this most striking of natural frames, almost a balcony leaning out towards the Borromeo Gulf, Stresa and the islands.

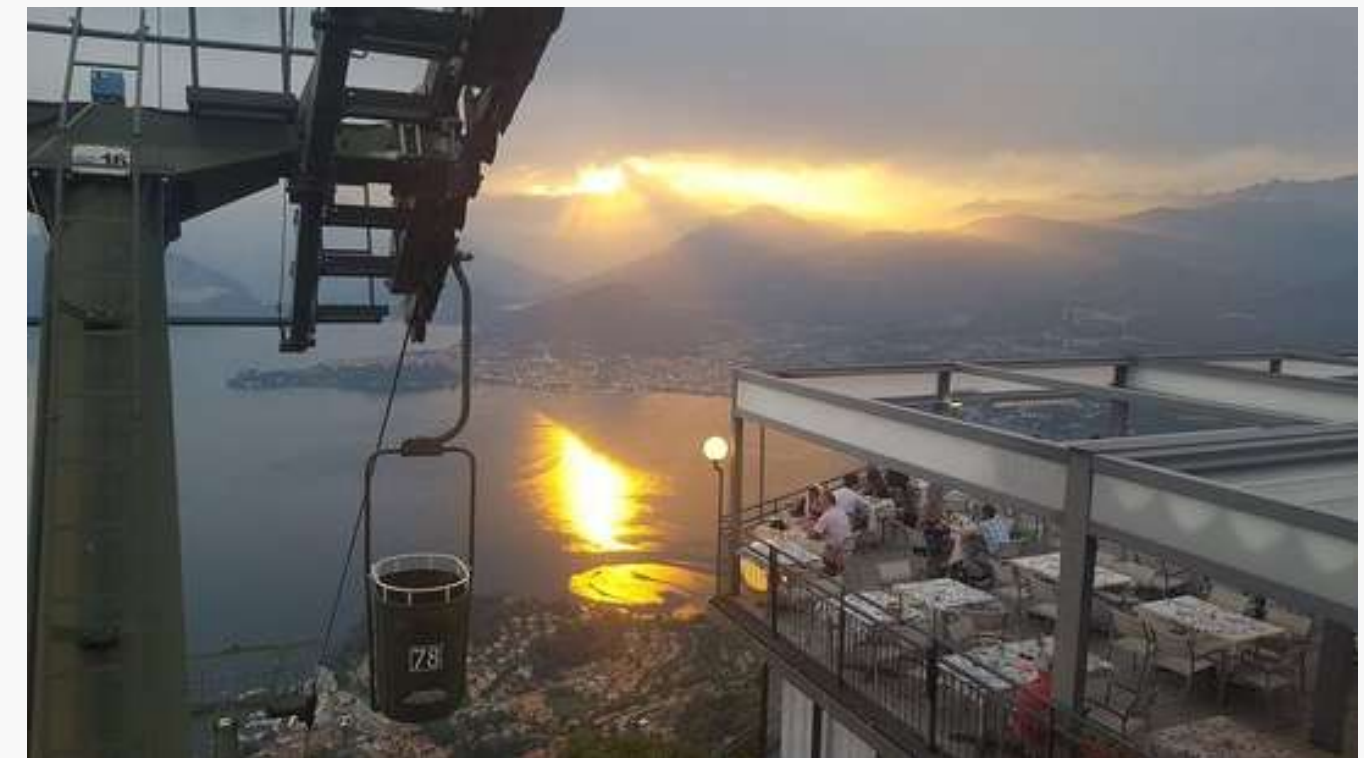

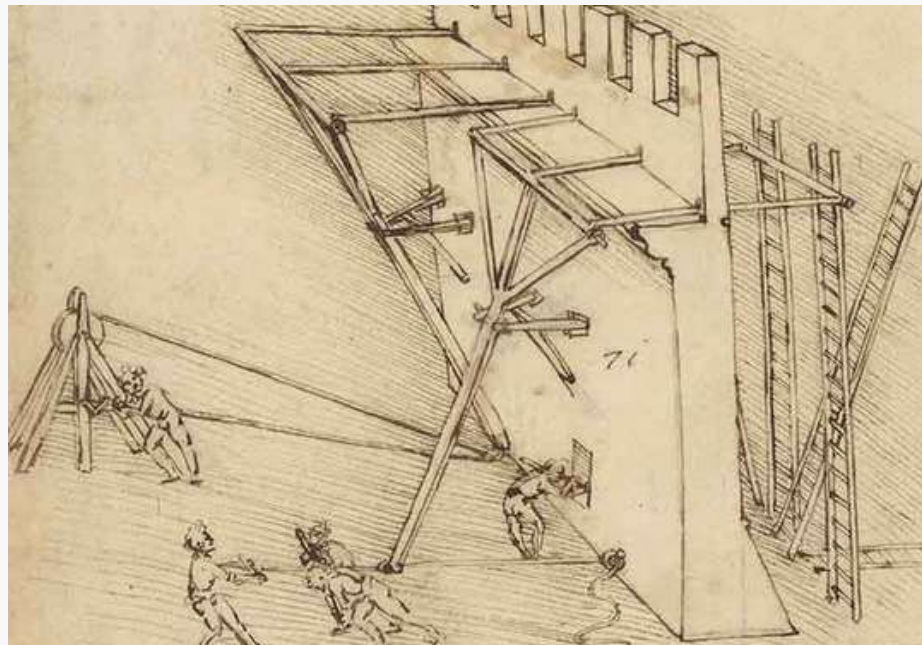

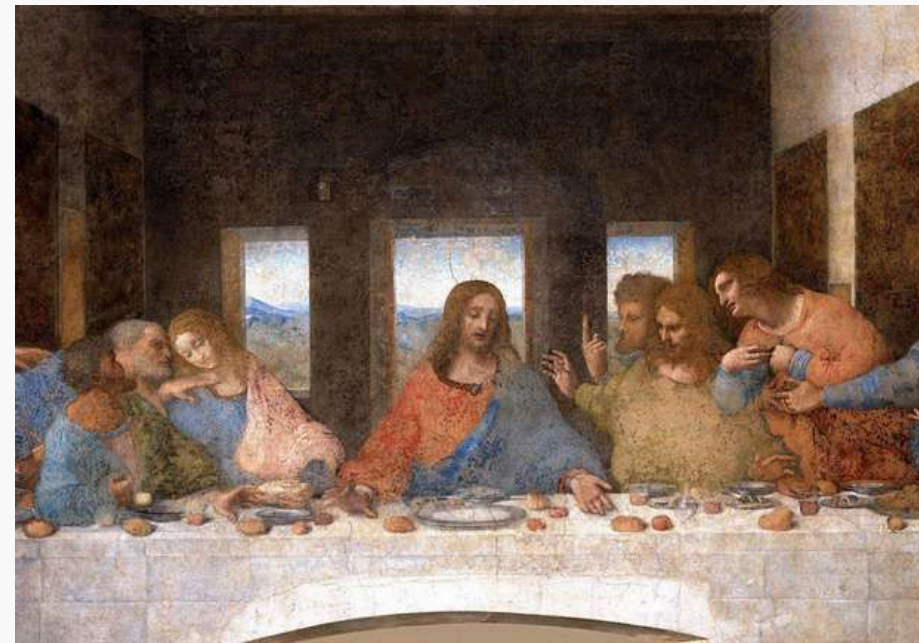

SHOAH MEMORIAL IN MILAN

The Shoah Memorial of Milan, Italy, is located deep within the city's Central Station on a sublevel below the main tracks. It was here that deportees arriving from San Vittore prison were loaded onto livestock cars.

It is a place symbolizing the deportation of the Jews and other persecuted peoples to concentration or death camps. It is a place for memory and awareness, a multifunctional center for conferences, seminars and exhibitions so that past atrocities will never find refuge in oblivion. Most importantly, it is a venue for dialogue and interchange among cultures, teaching the new generations to overcome linguistic, cultural and social barriers so that the extremes of brutality witnessed in the twentieth century—the Shoah being the absolute nadir of human barbarity—can never happen again.

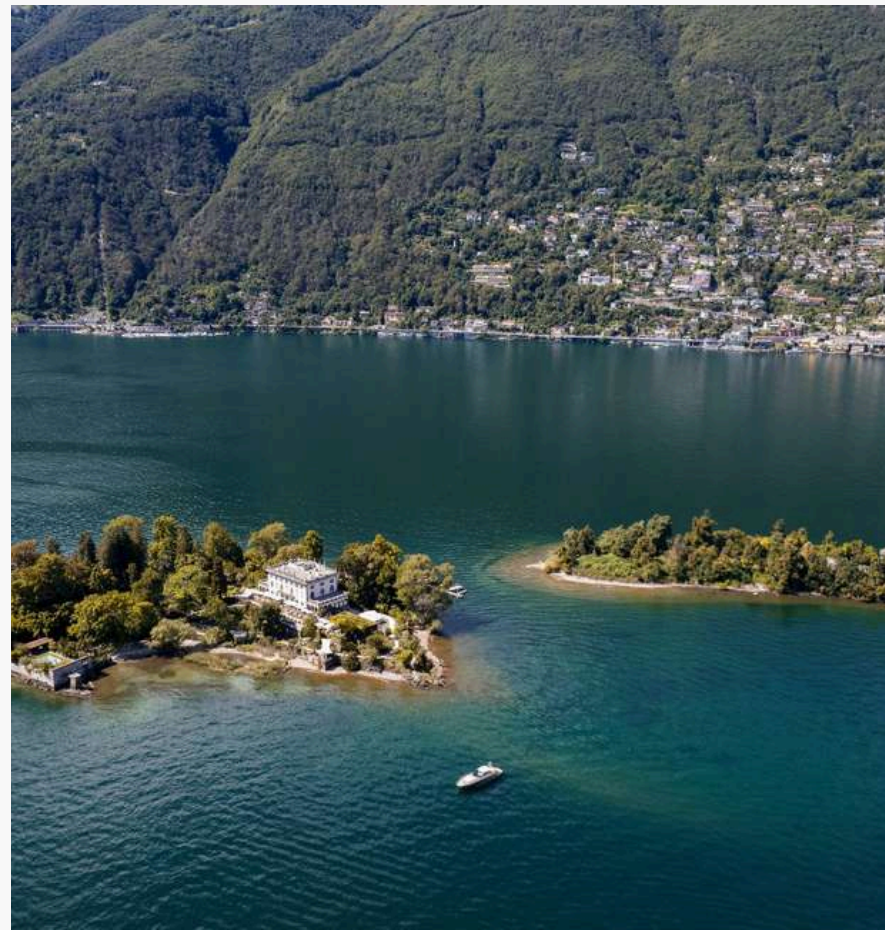

BERNINA EXPRESS

The Bernina Express is the slowest express panoramic train in Europe. The train goes from Tirano, in the province of Sondrio, to Coira (Chur) in the Canton of Grisons in Switzerland.

The Bernina Railway is the highest in Europe and one of the steepest in the world. The crossing of the Alps offers spectacular views and the route between Thusis and Tirano is also a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

The complete route from Tirano to Saint Moritz has a price of €35 per person, round trip so it will cost €70. If instead you choose first class, with wider and even more comfortable seats, the price one way is €59.
